Middlesex United Way provided Community Impact grants to Middlesex Habitat for Humanity of Connecticut in 2023 and 2024. This funding helped support the construction of a new home in East Hampton for Krystal Rivera and her family. Our team had the chance to work with Krystal while volunteering on the jobsite and enjoyed the experience. She and her family officially moved into the home in the summer of 2023.

In 2024, Middlesex Habitat for Humanity of CT began the process of shifting its construction model to energy-efficient, prefabricated homes. This initiative aligns with the goal to provide affordable housing options while bringing down costs to homeowners in the long run through energy efficient construction methods.
