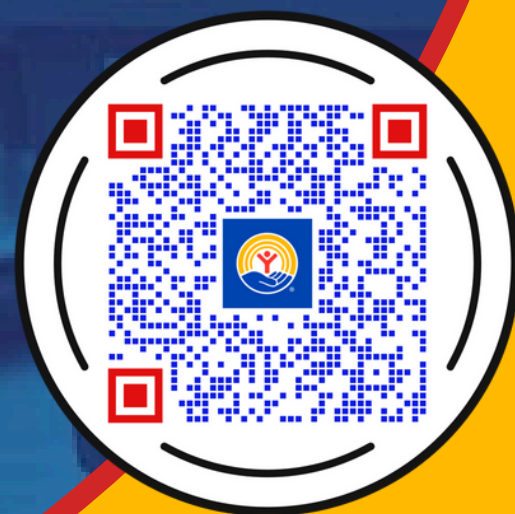
1. Collect non-perishable food items.
