




CHESTER




HELP IS JUST A CALL OR CLICK AWAY

In the past year, 112 Chester residents reached out to 2-1-1 for help. Nearly 44% of requests were for mental health and addiction support, while another 18% were for housing and shelter needs.

United Way's 2-1-1 is free, confidential, and available 24/7 – connecting Chester residents to the resources they need most.

In Chester, 40% of households are ALICE – Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed. These families work hard but still struggle to afford basics like housing, food, and health care.
